There is no Judgment on earth that takes place.	Christ judges all the inhabitants of the earth.
The Church is physically gathered together to Jesus.	Jesus Christ gathers the nations on earth to judge.
Only the Rapture is taught as being imminent.	The Second Coming happens at least 7 years later.
There are no signs preceding it.	There are 100's of signs preceding the 2nd Coming.
The Rapture will involve only the believers.	The Second Coming affects all of humanity.
It is a time of great joy and rejoicing.	The Second Coming it is a time of violence and fear.
The Rapture happens before the Tribulation period.	It happens immediately after the Tribulation period.
There is no mention of Satan.	Satan is bound for a thousand years.
Only those looking for Him will see Him.	Then every eye will see Him.
The Tribulation begins.	The Tribulation ends.
The Rapture takes us to the Marriage of the Lamb & His Bride.	Jesus Christ and the bride are seen descending.
There is a metamorphous to all believers.	There is no metamorphous described at all.
