He is not a creature in the created sense, but he possesses power and majesty beyond anything we've seen here on earth, beyond anything we can comprehend! And He is to be feared....right? Well, today, we'll meet Charles, a man who encountered many powerful forces in his life, and rightly learned to fear them. Until he discovered the power that ends all fear. He's here to share with us his true story on this Unshackled Daily Devotional.
- CHARLES: Why I went so wrong is hard to figure. My parents took me to church and Sunday school and wanted nothing but the best for me.I suppose it started with sports at which I excelled in high school,

earning me a scholarship to college. Popularity ushered in drinking, then drugs, as I experimented with every drug imaginable. Well, naturally, I dropped my athletic scholarship and became a drug head, dealing to support my addiction.

Hoping to reform, I moved back home after graduation where an old friend who had become a preacher tried to tell me about Jesus. I brushed him off and became even more immersed in the drug culture as a dealer. Trouble is, I was my own best customer, using cocaine until I came apart emotionally. I often cried myself to sleep, afraid of dying and what lay ahead.

Through cocaine I was drawn into a web of Satan worshippers, enticed by their promise of power even though I deeply feared the evil that surrounded them. When they betrayed me, I decided to end my life. I turned on the TV and heard a preacher talk about God's love and forgiveness no matter what we've done. I fell to the floor, weeping, and confessed my sins to a just and Holy God, asking Him to save me. Peace flooded my being.

Then I called my high-school-friend-turned-preacher, who let me stay with him while I grew in faith. I'm Charles Orr, and Jesus gave me victory over my addictions.
