Think of the South African flag. Can you name the colours in the flag?

One of the ways in which we can remember the good news is by looking at the different colours and using them to represent the meaning of the good news.

The blue represents our sin. As people, we sin. Our sin can come in the form of something as small as a lie.

The red represents Jesus’s blood on the cross. We know that Jesus was sent to earth so that He could die for our sins.

The white represents God’s forgiveness. When we are able to see where we have sinned, we can ask God for His forgiveness because Jesus made a way for us to have a relationship with God when He died for us.

The yellow represents our eternal life with God. When we give our lives to God, we have an everlasting life with Him.

Lastly, when we look at the green, it represents that we are able to grow and go. This means that we are constantly growing with God and as we grow, we are able to go out and share the good news of God.
