## GRANT CRAWFORD, ANDILE DLAMINI AND TRISTAN KIRN - ANNOUNCEMENT 5

**Grant:** "Tomorrow morning we go live with a whole bunch of services. 7am we have a Zulu service, 8am an English service, 9am a children's service, 10am another English service, 11am the kids are back on and at 12pm we have another Zulu service. At 6pm we have a youth meeting and so TK, you going to have to tell us how to get onto those live, because it's a combination of being live and not, we don't really understand that so tell us, how do we get on?"

**TK**: "So we've provided a couple of ways that you can access the whole services including kids, English, Zulu.

We've provided one way where maybe you have a bit of a slow internet and so you don't want to go live because you are not too sure what might happen. We've actually provided the links earlier on so that you can easily download them from the website. They are currently live so we're asking you to not play them until Sunday so that we can do it together as a church.

We are also going to go live and the best way to do that is actually to follow us on YouTube. The best way to be notified when we go live is to go to youtube.com, look for One Life Church and hit the subscription button so that when we go live, you get an email straight into your inbox.

You can also hit subscribe immediately on our website right now. It will give you the link and it will send you an email when we go live.

We've also introduced a children's devotional to go alongside the adult's devotional. The adult devotional comes at 7 in the morning and if you don't get the email the best way to get it is actually on Facebook and on our website. It'll be updated at that

time so you can make sure you're following us on Facebook or go onto the website. Same way with the kid's devotional."

Grant: "Let's talk a little bit about giving now because you know one of the things we can do under lockdown is we can retreat, we can just look after ourselves and well that's not really how the Lord wants us to live. And so we want to talk in a few moments about praying for other people, reaching out to other people but also, the government has allowed us to take a trip when we need to, to the supermarket to go and get bread and milk, to stock up the supplies for these 21 days. We are partnering with a whole bunch of Spar's and a few Pick n Pays around the region so when you go and buy your bread and milk, you can chuck some extra stuff into trolleys that have got One Life Foundation written on them and our guys are cruising around in the townships and going to other people in the inner city areas and people that have been notified by the site captains who are desperately in need right now. And it's fantastic that our guys can get around so apart from giving into a food trolley, we can also give online. And so that's where we give our tithes which keeps the church going and the gospel going and the ministries going etc. If you're not used to online giving, you can just hit a button. Tell us about that button."

**TK:** "There is a giving button and it'll tell you different ways that you can give. So there are various other options, EFT, Zapper, etc."

**Grant:** "We think that in these 21 days we should carry on tithing and giving to see the kingdom expand and at the same time also consider giving to the poor. We are helping them as a church but we can go way over and beyond that.

On Tuesday, we're going to call the church to a day of prayer and fasting. This is what it says in 2 chronicles 17. "If My people, who are called by My name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from Heaven and I will forgive their sin and I will heal their land."

The amazing thing about that text is that it's not saying the world must do it or the Government must do it or unchurched people must do it, He says, "If my people will pray and turn to Me, then I will bring healing to their land" and so the president has

called some prayer meetings and I trust you'll be praying along with him but as a church, let's pray.

We are going to be fasting every Tuesday.

Guys tell us how're we going to do the prayer meeting at 6 o'clock till 6:30 on Tuesday night?"

**TK:** "We really want to make sure that we feel together in this time of prayer and so what we're going to be doing is we're actually going to be live streaming our prayer meeting. We're going to have a bit of worship and it's all going to be live streamed on YouTube and so you want to make sure that you've subscribed to YouTube, you can do it either through YouTube or online and we will also be on Facebook.

Facebook will notify you when we are having a prayer meeting and so what's great about that is you can comment and you can tell us what you'd like us to pray for, what you're praying for, we've got guys who will reply to you online."

**Grant:** "So we think it's going to be a fantastic time. Andile is the worship leader, Tristen's the drummer, and they're both technical gurus. Their wives are dancers and play keyboards and so I don't know what that prayer is going to look like but I do know we are going live. You can interact with us and we are going to pray for our nation, we're going to trust God to bring healing to our land. So Andile, tell us what is the app looking like now?"

Andile: "Now you have access to all the daily devotionals and we've also created a kid's daily devotional as well so all those parents who are looking after their kids for the 21days, you'll have stuff to do with them to keep them connected to God and keep them active throughout the 21 day lockdown. We've also put together the Zulu sermons as well, they'll all be available there as well as the full service for the English and the Zulu services for the Sunday meetings. Those will be available as well. The audio is there as well if you struggle to watch it, you can click onto the

YouTube link as well. And if you want to just listen to it, you can download the link and it will give you the audio file."

**TK:** "We've really changed the website to make it a one stop shop during the lockdown to get different resources, services, and to make sure those devotionals are on there, to make sure there's leader's podcasts which we're going to be doing which will be exciting and all the things that we've been talking about, the foundation, it's really straight forward on the website, so please make use of the website so you can download everything we've been talking about."

**Grant:** "We believe that in these 21 days, God wants to meet with you. What an incredible moment to refresh in Jesus, get stuck into the bible, connect with your friends that are believers and non-believers and there is not a season under heaven that God can't be glorified and His church can't be built. This is no exception and so, Andile, last word from you."

Andile: "I would love to encourage everyone in light of Sunday morning, don't just sit in front of the TV screen or in front of your computer screen or your phone and just watch. Make it an important and spiritual moment. Connect with heaven, pray before you watch the movie, pray before you watch the service, pray together with your family, connect with heaven before you even watch. Ask God to speak to you because this is a moment where God can access your heart and God can commission you to be on mission. Enjoy the service."
