Now, take a few moments to read the description of each gift and reflect on how Jesus might be working through you...and others with different gifts than you! Think about these for more than just church life, but in your everyday life.

Apostle – The Builder

You're a starter, a strategist, a visionary. You see systems, structures, and steps that others miss, so you're often the one to say, "Why not us? Why not now?" Apostles aren't limited to pulpits or platforms. You're probably the friend who notices a gap and figures out how to fill it. You might launch new projects at work, help build up the dreams of others, or constantly think about how to grow what already exists so it can flourish on another level. You push people toward their purpose and multiply leaders around you. In the Kingdom, you build the Church by creating space for people to grow, launching new efforts, and helping people find where they fit.

Watch-out: Your desire to build and lead can sometimes turn into control or burnout if you're not careful. Trusting others with the vision, even when they build differently, keeps your influence healthy and sustainable.

Prophet – The Aligner

You have a deep sensitivity to the heart of God and a passion to help others align their lives with the truth of God. This doesn't mean you walk around predicting the future, it means you feel spiritual drift before others do. You might notice when your family is out of rhythm, or when a friend needs encouragement before they do, so you encourage them with scripture. You often speak what others are afraid to say, even though it could seem quick or judgmental at times. You try to carry truth like a compass, and while that can be weighty, it also brings people back to the center. In the Kingdom, you build the Church by calling people closer to the heart of God and keeping the Body of Christ from compromising.

Watch-out: You may be tempted to isolate yourself or become overly critical when others don't respond well to correction. Sometimes receiving correction can also make you defensive, because you already have such a heart for what is true. Make space for grace. Remember, even the truth needs to be delivered (and received) with love and patience

Evangelist – The Inviter

You can't help but share good news. Whether it's a new restaurant, a personal breakthrough, or your faith in Jesus, you're naturally wired to bring others in. You probably light up when people feel left out because you see them and have an opportunity to help them feel welcome. You love stories of redemption and second chances, and you often believe in people before they believe in themselves. You're not always trying to preach, you're just passionate that everyone deserves a shot at grace. In the Kingdom, you build the Church by expanding the family and reminding others what Jesus saved them for.

Watch-out: Your excitement for others can sometimes outpace their discipleship or rate of growth. Don't get discouraged if people don't respond quickly, and don't forget to help them grow after they say yes. Stay connected to a local church that can help them grow and don't assume that you have different visions when you really just have different functions.

Pastor – The Shepherd

You carry people in your heart. You feel what others feel, and you notice needs that others overlook. You might be the first one someone calls when they're hurting, and not because you have all the answers, but because they know you show up. Whether it's over coffee, in a text, or at the dinner table, your presence just naturally makes people feel safe. You bring calm to chaos. You may not lead a ministry, but you still lead relationally with compassion every day. In the Kingdom, you build the Church by tending to the people Jesus died for...reminding them they're loved and they belong.

Watch-out: Your deep empathy can sometimes lead to emotional exhaustion or rescuing people who need to take responsibility. Set healthy boundaries, and remember you're not their Savior...just someone pointing them to Him.

Teacher – The Explainer

You crave understanding, and you love helping others find it too. When something clicks for someone because of how you explained it, you feel alive. You probably find yourself clarifying ideas at work, helping your kids understand a tough question, or walking friends through hard topics in a way that just makes sense. You're patient with complex issues because you are committed to the truth, regardless of the subject matter. You tend to ask great questions and help others grow by guiding them as you learn more. In the Kingdom, you build the Church by helping people know God's Word and apply it in real life.

Watch-out: Your love for knowledge can lead to pride or frustration when others don't grasp things as quickly. Stay humble and work hard to stay relational. Remember that teaching isn't just about being right, it's about helping others walk in truth with lots of grace.

Here's what it boils down to: You're Not Just Gifted. You're Called!

Always remember that you didn't pick your gift. Jesus did. He gave it to you, but it's not a reward. He gave it to you as a responsibility. That's how much He trusts you!

You were made to carry something others need. The Church is not complete without you. You don't need to feel ready to start...you just need to be willing.

Don't wait until you feel like an expert. Start by serving someone. Encouraging someone. Sharing truth. Asking hard questions. Welcoming the outsider. Whatever your gift looks like... use it.

You grow by doing, not by sitting still. Jesus didn't give you this gift to keep it hidden...in fact, every gift we receive from the Lord is designed for someone else! He gave it to you so the Church could grow, the lost could be found, and the hurting could be healed.

Now that you know what He placed inside you...let's go build something that lasts.
