# Losing My Religion - More Than Tradition liberty church

#### Matthew 28:18-20 & Acts 8:32-38

- Baptism is commanded by Jesus in the "Great Commission"
- Why don't we have the same urgency to be obedient to the Lord as seen in Acts 8?
  - How do we move closer to Jesus through baptism?

#### 1. From Death to Life

- Baptism isn't a Christian "merit badge"...it's a public burial. A funeral for the old "me".
- 1 Corinthians 10:1-2 (Baptism was foreshadowed in the story of Moses)
- 1 Peter 3:20-21 (Baptism was foreshadowed in the story of Noah)
- Romans 6:1-11 (Baptism doesn't just bury the "old" me...it resurrects a "new" me into new life!)
- It's not about being a "better version of me". It's becoming brand new from the core of who you are.

### **Losing My Religion - More Than Tradition**



#### **How Can I Move from Death to Life?**

- Reflect: Have I truly been made new in Christ? (Be honest with yourself...don't assume)
- Respond: Is it time to be baptized—or re-committed?(Don't let pride or shame get in the way)
- 3. Reclaim Your Identity. (It won't be a one-time decision either...)

### 2. From Cleansing to Calling

- Baptism isn't a "graduation"...it's a point where what has been developing privately becomes public.
  - Titus 3:4-7 (Mercy AND empowerment!)
- Think of the picture of the snow on Mount Hermon melting, flowing through the Jordan River, only to arrive in the Dead Sea where nothing can live. That's baptism!
- Romans 8:10-11 & 14-17 (When we identify with Jesus...His Father becomes OUR Father!)
