1. Read Romans 12:9-13 and 1 Corinthians 13. What are similarities describing how we should love in both of these passages?
2. What is the difference between authentic and hypocritical love? In Romans 12:9, God commands for love to be genuine. What does genuine/authentic love look like? And what does hypocritical love look like?
3. Romans 12:10 says to be devoted to one another. The world is quick to cast out and cancel. The word commands us to be devoted in our relationships. If someone makes a mistake, we're not quick to leave. We're quick to remind them that we're not going anywhere. What does this look like in real time? Why is this easier said than done?
4. Romans 12:12 tells us to be constant and consistent in our love. The greatest gift you can give your spouse is consistent love. The greatest gift you can give your kids is consistent love. The greatest gift you can give your church, community, and friendship circle is consistent love. And be consistent in how you show it. What happens when we are inconsistent in our love?
