2 Samuel 12:16-20 NIV - [16] David pleaded with God for the child. He <u>fasted</u> and <u>spent the</u> <u>nights lying in sackcloth on the ground</u>. [17] <u>The elders of his household stood beside</u> <u>him to get him up from the ground</u>, but <u>he refused</u>, and he <u>would not eat any food with</u> <u>them</u>. [18] <u>On the seventh day the child died</u>. David's attendants were afraid to tell him that the child was dead, for they thought, "While the child was still living, he wouldn't listen to us when we spoke to him. How can we now tell him the child is dead? He may do something desperate." [19] David noticed that his attendants were whispering among themselves, and <u>he realized the child was dead. "Is the child dead?" he asked. "Yes," they replied, "he is dead."</u> [20] <u>Then David got up from the ground</u>. After he had <u>washed</u>, put on <u>lotions</u> and <u>changed his clothes</u>, he <u>went into the house of the Lord and worshiped</u>. Then he <u>went to his own house</u>, and <u>at his request they served him food, and he ate</u>.

James 1:5 NIV - Then, after <u>desire</u> has conceived it gives birth to <u>sin</u>; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to <u>death</u>.

THE JUDGMENT

2 Samuel 12:13-14 NIV - Then David said to Nathan, "I have sinned against the Lord." Nathan replied, "The <u>Lord has taken away your sin. You are not going to die</u>. [14] But because by doing this you have shown utter contempt for the Lord, <u>the son born to you will die</u>."

- Be grown enough to admit what you did.
- God can lift things off of you when you admit what you have done.

THE JUDGMENT

2 Samuel 12:18 NIV - On the seventh day the child died.

• You have to live with your mess. It's the wrong time to make a bigger mess because you didn't get what you wanted.

CROSS ROAD - TO SIT IN IT OR MOVE ON?

2 Samuel 12:19 NIV - David noticed that his attendants were whispering among themselves, and <u>he realized the child was dead. "Is the child dead?" he asked. "Yes," they replied, "he is dead."</u>

- The longer you sit in your mess the more you cut yourself off.
- You can't afford to die in a messy situation.

Are you letting your mess define you?

GET UP

2 Samuel 12:20a NIV - Then David got up from the ground.

• You can't get what is for you until you get up.

What mess are you wallowing in? How long do you plan to sit there?

CLEAN UP

2 Samuel 12:20b NIV - After he had <u>washed</u>, put on <u>lotions</u> and <u>changed his clothes</u>,

• You cannot look like the mess you've been in.

What is your current countenance? Do you wear what you have been through on your outer appearance? If so, why?

LIFT HIM UP

Samuel 12:20c NIV - he went into the house of the Lord and worshiped.

• Worship God even if the outcome is not what you wanted.

What will it take for you to worship God in the midst of your mess?

REASON TO WORSHIP

Samuel 12:13b NIV - Nathan replied, "The <u>Lord has taken away your sin. You are not</u> going to die.

• There are some things that will not change. Worship God anyway.

EAT UP

2 Samuel 12:20d NIV - Then he <u>went to his own house</u>, and <u>at his request they served him</u> <u>food, and he ate</u>.

• Stop living beneath your privileges. There is so much more for you. What are you feeding your spirit man?

YOUR CALLING IS BIGGER THAN YOUR MISTAKE.

Psalm 51:10-13 NIV - Create in me a <u>clean heart</u>, O God; And renew a <u>right spirit</u> within me. [11] Cast me not away from thy <u>presence</u>; and take not thy <u>holy spirit</u> from me. [12] Restore unto me the <u>joy</u> of thy salvation; And uphold me with thy <u>free</u> spirit. [13] Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; And sinners shall be converted unto thee.

- David wrote the 51st Psalm after his mistake.
- God did not deliver you to hide or be ashamed.
- What you have been through will allow you to impact the kingdom.

What testimony are you still holding on to? Why haven't you used it to bless others?
