Look at your life and you will see that, *it's all coming together*.

REMEMBER

Matthew 1:22 NIV - All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet.

1 John 1:3 NIV - We proclaim to you what we have <u>seen</u> and <u>heard</u>, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ.

• You can only testify about what you have heard and what you have seen.

What have you seen or heard that confirms your promise?

HEAVEN

Luke 2:13-14 NIV - [13] *Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying,* [14] "*Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests.*"

- God will send an army (heavenly hosts) to protect what He promised you.
- Before the earth gets the promise, God releases it in heaven.

Psalm 148:2 NIV - "Praise him, all his angels; praise him, all his heavenly hosts."

What sound or praise are you releasing? How are you calling heaven to earth?

SHEPHERDS – HEAR

Luke 2:17-18 NIV - When they had <u>seen him</u>, they spread the word concerning what had been <u>told them about this child</u>, [18] and all who <u>heard it</u> were amazed at what the shepherds said to them.

- In God's Kingdom, you will always hear before you see. Learn to move when you hear and don't wait until you see.
- Say what you hear until you see what you heard.
- Learn to see with your ears because everything in the seen begins in the unseen.

Do you take action when you hear or when you see? What prevents you from trusting what you hear (before you can see it)?

Luke 2:20 NIV - The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, *which were <i>just as they had been told*.

- Don't wait until it happens to give your response.
- Your one response is to act like it has already happened.

Isaiah 46:11b KJV - I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.

What has God spoken to you that has yet to come to pass? How are you responding to what you heard?

MAGI (WISE MEN) - SEE

Matthew 2:2 NIV - and asked, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? <u>We saw</u> <u>his star</u> when it rose and have come to <u>worship him</u>."

- You have to remember everything you heard and saw. God is expecting a praise out of you.
- Remember your journey and where you came from.

Matthew 2:10-11 NIV - [10] When they <u>saw</u> the star, they were <u>overjoyed</u>. [11] On coming to the house, they <u>saw the child with his mother Mary</u>, and <u>they bowed down and</u> <u>worshiped him</u>. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

• Get excited about your future. Pour out your worship on God for what you have seen.

How will you respond when you see God's promise(s) come to pass?

QUESTION

What do you do when a promise is revealed to you?

DECLARATION

I'm about to align my life to what I see and hear. I'm going to decree a thing until I see what I say and my one response is to glorify and praise God.

PRAYER

To the Sovereign God who seats on the throne of my heart and knows everything about me. The One who has given me a word over my life, who aligned the right people to my life, and who has ordered my steps to be in the right place at the right time. Today, I thank you for the gift of life, and that I will see what I heard. Thank you for being the author and finisher of my faith and I will decree a thing until it's established.
