PEACE IS A PROMISE

Psalm 29:11 - The LORD gives strength to his people; the LORD blesses his people with peace.

• Peace is not something you work for or earn, but a gift from God.

PEACE IS A PROTECTOR

Phillipians 4:7 - And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

• You have to protect your peace. Learn to put the stress down and pick up the gift of peace.

PEACE IS FOR YOUR PROCESS

Galatians 5:22-23 - But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

• God knows you will need peace for the decisions you will have to make and the places you will go.

Jesus calming the storm is one of the miracles of Jesus reported in the Synoptic Gospels -Matthew 8:23–27, Mark 4:35–41, and Luke 8:22–25.

Mark 4:35 - On the same day, when evening had come, He said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side."

- Your Kingdom assignment is to make it to the other side! You can't let anyone or anything stop you.
- Your destination has been predetermined, but you must be determined to reach your destination.

What detours has the enemy taken you on to stop you from getting to your destination? Do you know and understand the destiny God has for you?

STORMS ARE EVENT(S) OR A SERIES OF EVENTS IN OUR LIVES THAT GOD USES TO TEACH US NECESSARY LESSONS FOR OUR LIVES.

Mark 4:37 ESV - And a great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling.

- Your progress makes the enemy nervous. It's not *will* you go through, it's *how* you go through the storm.
- Storms don't come to last, they come to pass.
- God knows how to handle the storm. He is the storm handler.

What storms have you recently been in or currently in? Do you remember what God told you before the storm?

JESUS TEACHES US HOW TO HANDLE A STORM

1. GO TO SLEEP

Mark 4:38a - But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow.

- Remember what God told you before the storm.
- Learn to rest in your revelation. God will reveal your *rest* in your *rest*.
- You can do more rested than when you are restless. Come into the rest of God.

Research reveals the power of sleep to restore mental health. - Psychology Today

Psalm 4:8 - In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, Lord, make me dwell in safety.

Mark 4:38b - ... And they awoke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?"

• Either you're going to pray your problems or pray your promises.

What is your reaction when storms arise? Do you know how to rest when you are in the midst of a storm?



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YOUR PEACE WILL BE PROTECTED OR DISRUPTED BASED ON WHO YOU SPEND YOUR TIME WITH.

2. STAND UP

Mark 4:39- Then He arose and rebuked the wind,

- The change you want is on the other side of the decision you need to make.
- You have to confront the storm/situation/problem head on to have peace.
- Peacemaking requires confrontation. Have the conversation.

Are there areas of your life you have been avoiding to confront? How will you stand up in this situation?

WHAT YOU WON'T CONFRONT, WILL NOT CHANGE. YOUR PEACE WILL COST CONFRONTATION.

3. SPEAK UP

Mark 4:39b - ...and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!" And the wind ceased and there was a great calm.

- Jesus also said, "Be still." The Greek word is *pefimoso* meaning to muzzle, silence, and cause to be speechless.
- Jesus takes away the storms' ability to "speak" and rage.
- You need to deal with the spirit behind the person/situation, then deal with the person.
- Your storm is waiting for you to speak. The enemy will try to make you silent or make the wrong confession.

Mark 4:40 - But He said to them, "Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?"

• You will outlast this storm.

What difficult situation is waiting for you to speak to it? How long have you been agonizing over it? What will it take for you to speak up?

JESUS TOLD THE SEA TO "SHUT UP" SO THAT IT WOULDN'T SWALLOW THE SHIP.

Philippians 4:7 - And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
