WASH YOUR HANDS with soap & water for 20 seconds frequently throughout the day. Especially after using the restroom, before eating, after coughing/sneezing, and when you come home from public places. *Hand sanitizer (with 60% alcohol) is effective too.*



CLEAN & DISINFECT frequently touched surfaces daily including: your cell phone, door handles, knobs, switches, your car steering wheel, computer keyboards, and surfaces you prepare food on. If you don't have disinfectant wipes, regular household cleaners work.



PRACTICE GOOD RESPIRATORY ETTIQUETE cover your cough/sneeze with a tissue and throw it away. If you don't have a tissue, use your elbow, not your hands. *Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.*



STAY HOME WHEN YOU ARE SICK including public places and church. If you have a cough with fever, or shortness of breath, stay home and CALL your family doctor or the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit at 519-258-2146.



AVOID CLOSE CONTACT WITH PEOPLE WHO ARE SICK, sneezing or coughing. Temporarily, avoid shaking hands when greeting people.
