An Open Door No One Can Shut — Georges Housney — Revelation 3:6-8

Begin your study by reading Revelation 3:6-8 as a group

Head

These questions help us understand who God is, who we are, what Scripture teaches, etc.

- What stood out to you about the passage or message this week? Any further questions?
- How does Jesus describe himself in Revelation 3:7? What does he intend to communicate about himself with each descriptive term?

Heart

These questions help us align what we know in our minds with what we believe in our hearts.

- Georges shared many stories about how God has opened door after door in seemingly impossible situations. What story impacted you the most and why? How did his stories challenge you?
- Think back on your life. Has God ever opened a door that seemed closed (if yes, please share)? How do you hope that God will use your life to impact others with the Gospel?

Hands

These questions help us get practical with what we have learned.

- Jesus encourages us to “see” or “behold” the open door he lays in front of us (verse 8). Do you see any open doors in your life right now? Where might God want to use you to bring others to Him?
- Spend extra time in prayer tonight, asking God to open doors, open your eyes to Gospel opportunities, and lead you where he wants you to go.

Pray

Since God speaks through His word, take time to respond through prayer.

Praise – what has our passage taught us about God that we can praise/thank Him for?

Confession – what has our passage revealed that we need to repent of?

Requests – what requests can we bring to God on behalf of ourselves and each other?
