The Birth of the Church (Part 1) — David Horner — Acts 2:1-13

Begin your study by reading Acts 2:1-13 as a group

Head

These questions help us understand who God is, who we are, what Scripture teaches, etc.

- What stood out to you about the passage or message this week? Any further questions?
- Why do you think Jesus chose to send the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost? What about Pentecost made it a suitable day for the Spirit to come?

Heart

These questions help us align what we know in our minds with what we believe in our hearts.

- The phenomena of wind, fire, and new tongues indicates that the coming of the Holy Spirit brought power, purity, passion, and new purpose to the disciples.
 - Like D.L. Moody, do you feel that you are walking the power of the Spirit, or do you need to pray for a personal Pentecost in your life?
 - In what ways might the Spirit want to purify you in preparation for the work he wants to do in your life?
 - Is there anyone in your life who you “speak the language” of? That is, who has God uniquely empowered you to share about His mighty works in a way they can understand?
- How have you experienced mockers in your life? How have you dealt with seekers in your life? Is there anything you would do different when dealing with either one after reading the story of Pentecost?

Hands

These questions help us get practical with what we have learned.

- Pentecost is all about the harvest. Jesus said the fields are ripe for harvest if we will lift our eyes. When you look around your life, where do you see God at work? Where can you join Him in His great harvest?

Pray

Since God speaks through His word, take time to respond through prayer.

Praise – what has our passage taught us about God that we can praise/thank Him for?

Confession – what has our passage revealed that we need to repent of?

Requests – what requests can we bring to God on behalf of ourselves and each other?
