HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Jesus Opens — Doug Horner — Luke 24:13-49

Begin your study by reading Luke 24:13-49 as a group

Head

These questions help us understand who God is, who we are, what Scripture teaches, etc.

- What stood out to you about the passage or message this week? Do you have any further questions you'd like to discuss?
- Jesus "interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself" (vs. 27). What does this verse tell us about how we should properly read and understand the Bible? What are some of the most striking ways that we see Jesus in the Old Testament?

Heart

These questions help us align what we know in our minds with what we believe in our hearts.

- Jesus obviously knew about everything that had happened in Jerusalem (it had happened to him!) and yet he asked the disciples, "What Things [Happened]?" (vs. 19).
 What does this tell us about the heart of Christ and our prayers?
- In vs. 31-32, the disciples have their eyes opened and recognize Jesus. They say of the encounter: "Did not our hearts burn within us?" Can you relate to the disciples in that:
 - You've spent time around Jesus, but haven't seen him for who he truly is?
 - You've had an "aha!" moment with Jesus?
 - You've had an encounter with Jesus where your "heart burned within you"?

Hands

These questions help us get practical with what we have learned.

- We have to make time for the Bible if we want Jesus to help us understand it. What resources, tools, and practices have you found helpful for your personal Bible study?
- What can you take from the passage and apply to your life this week?

Pray

Since God speaks through His word, take time to respond through prayer.

Praise – what has our passage taught us about God that we can praise/thank Him for?

Confession – what has our passage revealed that we need to repent of?

Requests – what requests can we bring to God on behalf of ourselves and each other?
