

# HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Sunday, March 21st, 2021

Mark 5:24-34 — David Horner — Simply Jesus

1. This week, Pastor David shared about experiencing Jesus in your life. Share about a time when you felt you experienced the presence of Jesus in your life.
2. In Mark 5:25-26, we learn that the woman with the issue of blood had spent her money on various physicians and treatments and yet grew worse. She was truly in a desperate situation.
  - Recall a time when you were in a difficult or even desperate situation. How did this season impact your relationship and reliance upon God?
  - How can we learn to rely upon Jesus daily, even if we don't feel that we are in a desperate situation?
3. Read Mark 5:27-31. The crowd rubbed shoulders with Jesus and received nothing. The woman touched Jesus with intention and was healed.
  - In what ways do you feel we rub shoulders with Jesus on a daily basis?
  - How can we make our lives a more intentional pursuit of Jesus instead of a passive pursuit?
  - Read and discuss Psalm 1:1-2, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, and Ephesians 6:5-8 for some ideas on how to intentionally pursue Jesus.
4. Read Mark 5:34. The key to the woman's healing was her faith.
  - Read Hebrews 11:1, Hebrews 11:6, James 1:5-8, Romans 3:28. How would you describe faith based on your reading of these verses?
  - Do you ever feel like the man in Mark 9:21-24? According to Romans 10:17, how can you build your faith?
5. The healing of the woman in Mark 5 is a picture of the gospel and how Jesus will heal us of our sin if we put our faith in Him. In what ways can you remind yourself of the gospel this week?
