# **HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

Sunday, April 21th, 2024

The Chosen One — David Horner — 1 Samuel 16

Begin your study by reading 1 Samuel 16 as a group

#### Head

These questions help us understand who God is, who we are, what Scripture teaches, etc.

- What stood out to you about the passage or message this week? Any further questions?
- Read Luke 4:17-19, 2 Corinthians 1:21-22, 1 John 1:19-20. The word "Anointed" gets used a lot these days. But what do you think the Biblical concept of being "anointed" is? How does this impact your life?

#### Heart

These questions help us align what we know in our minds with what we believe in our hearts.

- "Man looks on the outward appearance but the LORD looks on the heart." How do you
  see this statement brought to life in the person of Jesus? How does this truth affect your
  own life?
- In what ways are you tempted to care more about the outer appearance than the heart in your own life? How does the cultural elevation of outer appearance affect the way you look at others?
- God prepared David for what's ahead while he was in the pasture. In what ways is God using your current circumstances, no matter how mundane, to shape you?

### **Hands**

These questions help us get practical with what we have learned.

• Read Acts 1:6-8. God's Spirit rushed upon David to empower him as God's King. What mission does the Holy Spirit empower Jesus' disciples to accomplish? How does this apply to your life?

## **Pray**

Since God speaks through His word, take time to respond through prayer.

Praise – what has our passage taught us about God that we can praise/thank Him for?

**Confession** – what has our passage revealed that we need to repent of?

**Requests** – what requests can we bring to God on behalf of ourselves and each other?
