Key Passage: John 3:14-21

Questions for discussion:



- 1. What does condemned mean? What does it mean not to be condemned?
- 2. How do those who place their faith in Jesus mirror the Israelites afflicted by snakes in the wilderness?
- 3. What is Jesus implying by calling Himself the Son of Man?
- 4. How is the death of Jesus a direct result of God's love for us?
- 5. In what ways might John 3:16 change how you view and respond to sin in your own life?
- 6. What does it mean to truly believe in Christ?
- 7. What are the results for not believing in Christ?

Prayer Prompt

- Acknowledge to God that you are in need of a Savior and pray that He would forgive you of your sins and rebellion against Him.
- Pray for those that don't believe. That God would convict them and bring them to repentance.
- Pray that God would use you in communicating the truth about His Son to others.
- Pray that God would diminish the attraction of the sin that holds you prisoner.
