Key Passage: John 3:1-13

Questions for discussion:



- 1. What stood out to you from this sermon/passage?
- 2. What do we know about Nicodemus from this passage?
- 3. How was Nicodemus different from the other Pharisees Jesus interacted with?
- 4. What is the significance of Jesus comparing the Holy Spirit to the wind? (Jn. 3:8)
- 5. What does it mean to be born again?
- 6. How can I know if I am born again?
- 7. What does it mean to be born of water and Spirit? (Jn. 3:5)
- 8. Why is it good news to know that God is the one that causes new birth?
- 9. Can you trace back and describe when you were born again?



Prayer Prompt

- Pray that God would show you where you have made Christianity a religion rather than a relationship.
- Pray for friends and family that have not experienced new birth; that they would turn to the Lord and be saved (Is. 45:22)
- Pray that we would trust in God and keep our eyes fixed on Jesus.
