









Sermon: Living Water

Key Passage: John 4:1-18



Questions for discussion:

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon/passage?
- 2. Why did Jesus *have to pass through* Samaria and why is this important to the text? (4:4)
- 3. Why was there a rift between Jews and Samaritans?
- 4. What is the significance of the well Jesus stops at for a drink?
- 5. How do we access the living water Jesus offers? (7:37-39)
- 6. Why do you think Jesus exposed the Samaritan woman's colored past? (4:16-18).
- 7. Read Jeremiah 2:13. What is a broken cistern (literally and figuratively)?
- 8. How is the living water Jesus offers both universal and personal?
- 9. What are ways we can stay "hydrated" by the Spirit and not the world?



Prayer Prompts

- Jesus, help me identify the broken cisterns of the past and present. Let me be completely satisfied in you..
- Read Psalm 139. Ask God to search your heart.
- I pray for those who feel discarded and forgotten; that they would encounter Jesus.
