Key Passage: John 5:1-18

Questions for discussion:

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon/passage?
- 2. What does this passage want us to believe about Jesus?
- 3. How does authentic faith in Christ manifest itself as faithfulness in the life of a believer?
- 4. What are some passages that show Jesus's authority over all things? How can we locate them?
- 5. Why is it important to note that the healing in this passage is not a faith healing?
- 6. How had the Pharisees misunderstood the purpose of the Sabbath?
- 7. Are there things you say you believe, yet there is no evidence of it in your life?
- 8. Does your belief in Jesus spur you to submit and obey, or rebel and compromise?
- 9. What steps could you take to fight to obey Christ and show yourself as one approved?
- 10. What areas do you need to align your thinking back to what the Bible says?

- Pray God would reveal any unbelief and incorrect thinking
- Pray for a renewed passion and love for God's word and to be useful for God's kingdom
- Pray for knowledge, wisdom, discernment, and understanding so you may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
