Sermon: *Christ Exalted Over All*

Key Passage: *John 3:31-36*

Questions for discussion:



1. What stood out to you from this sermon or passage?
2. What can we learn about Jesus from this passage?
3. In what ways is Jesus like us and in what ways is he different?
4. What does it mean that Jesus is "above all"? How is this good news? (v. 31)
5. How is Jesus' testimony about God believable and trustworthy? (v. 33)
6. How was the Holy Spirit involved in the life and ministry of Jesus? (v. 34)
7. Based on John 3:36, what is the consequence for rejecting Christ?
8. Is belief *and* obedience necessary to follow Christ or just belief? (v. 36)
9. What is God's wrath? Is God's wrath just or cruel? Explain.
10. How does believing in Christ give us hope for today and for all eternity?

- Pray that you would give the Holy Spirit all-access to your heart as Christ did.
- Pray that you would see Christ over all areas of your life.
- Pray for continued understanding of the hope found in Christ both now and forever.
- Pray for a greater understanding of God's holiness and love (Rom. 11:22; Prov. 9:10).
