- 1. What stood out to you from this sermon or passage?
- 2. What can we learn about Jesus from this passage?
- 3. In what ways is Jesus like us and in what ways is he different?
- 4. What does it mean that Jesus is "above all"? How is this good news? (v. 31)
- 5. How is Jesus' testimony about God believable and trustworthy? (v. 33)
- 6. How was the Holy Spirit involved in the life and ministry of Jesus? (v. 34)
- 7. Based on John 3:36, what is the consequence for rejecting Christ?
- 8. Is belief and obedience necessary to follow Christ or just belief? (v. 36)
- 9. What is God's wrath? Is God's wrath just or cruel? Explain.
- 10. How does believing in Christ give us hope for today and for all eternity?
