Questions for discussion:

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon/passage?
- 2. What evidence from this passage shows this woman was transformed?
- 3. What is the significance of the woman leaving her water jar behind?
- 4. What can get in the way of us sharing our faith with others?
- 5. How can a transformed life be a powerful witness to the world for Jesus?
- 6. What is the food Jesus is referring to in John 4:32?
- 7. What is the harvest Jesus is referring to in verse 35?
- 8. What were some of the barriers that prevented the disciples from seeing the harvest?
- 9. What barriers prevent us from seeing the harvest around us?
- 10. Read 1 Corinthians 3:5-9. Who are people that have planted or watered seeds of faith in your life?



Prayer Prompts

- Pray that the "eyes of your heart" would be opened to see the harvest around you.
- Pray for those who God is calling you to plant or water seeds of faith.
- Pray that you would leave behind things that may hinder you from making disciples.
