Sermon: Jesus gives His church their mission. In some of His final words to his disciples, he outlines what he expects them to do and how he expects them to do it after his departure.

Key Passage: Matthew 18:18-20



- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon/passage?
- 2. What is the importance of verse 18?
- 3. Do you view the Great Commission as a burden or a joy?
- 4. Last week we learned that no one comes to Jesus unless the Father draws him. Why then, does the Great Commission matter if the Father is already doing the work? Read Romans 10:9-15
- 5. Who in your life are you walking in co-mission with? How are you doing this?
- 6. Where is Jesus, in His authority, calling you to action?
- 7. What is the promise found in verse 20? How does this make you feel? What are some of it's implications?

- Pray for God to create divine appointments where you live, learn, work and play to live out the Great Commission.
- Pray for God to reveal where He wants you to put your faith into action.
