<u>Bible & Interpretation</u>

Q11 – What's a woman's role in ministry in light of 1 Timothy 2.12?

Q12 – How do we reconcile Scripture's apparent approval of slavery (Lev 25) with its evil institution in our nation's history?

Q13 – Does Scripture preclude making any images of Jesus (e.g., paintings, film, children's Bible or teaching curriculum)?

<u>Bible & Interpretation</u>

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 <u>1 Tim 2.8-14</u> – I desire that in every place [of worship] the men should pray, lifting holy hands without anger or quarreling; ⁹ likewise also that women should adorn themselves in respectable apparel, with modesty and self-control, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly attire, ¹⁰ but with what is proper for women who profess godliness—with good works. ¹¹ Let a woman learn quietly with all submissiveness. ¹² I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet. ¹³ For Adam was formed first, then Eve; ¹⁴ and Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived and became a transgressor.

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- <u>1 Tim 3.14-15</u> I am writing these things to you so that...you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God

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 - Celebrant sacramentally represents/communicates Jesus
 - This is my body ... this is my blood
 - A woman celebrating *in persona Christi* ("this is my body") would confuse (obscure) the sacramental representation
 - God the Son perfectly images & reveals the Father in flesh
 - The Triune God is masculine as to all Creation ... & ...

<u>Bible & Interpretation</u>

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- Latitude for Women Teaching in the PCA in Non-Worship —Allows <u>3 interpretations</u> of "authoritative teaching"—
 - 1 Only teach women and/or children under the authority of church leadership (Session)
 - 2 Teach mixed adult gender groups with her husband or an elder present, and under the Session's authority
 - 3 Teach mixed adult gender groups under the Session's authority.
- #2 and/or #3 the practice of All Saints, UT RUF, PCPC, et al

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• <u>Acts 18:26</u>—Apollos [a man] "spoke and taught accurately the things concerning Jesus, though he knew only the baptism of John. ... but when Priscilla [a woman] and Aquila [her husband] heard Apollos, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately."

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 - Priscilla taught Apollos outside of Eucharistic worship
 - Some: Priscilla's name preceding her husband possibly indicates some sort of priority
 - Priscilla taught Apollos Scripture without transgressing Paul's admonition in 1 Tim 2 (like a Sunday morning class)

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<u>Bible & Interpretation</u>

- The Holy Spirit poured out gifts on both men and women at Pentecost, for use in and thru the church
- <u>Teaching</u> by women is within the bounds we've discussed
- <u>Diaconal service</u> by women (deaconesses) is within PCA bounds
- <u>Public Worship</u> involvement by women is within PCA bounds
 - E.g., leading in singing, reading Scripture, praying, distributing the Lord's Supper, offerings, making announcements, greeting, ushering
