Psalm 119:25-48 Daleth

Right: I am laid low In the dust; preserve our lives according to your word. **Left**: We gave an account of our ways and you answered us; teach us your decrees.

Right: Cause us to understand the way of your precepts, that we may meditate on your wonderful deeds.

Left: Our souls are weary with sorrow; strengthen us according to your word.

Right: Keep us from deceitful ways; be gracious to me and teach your law. **Left**: We have chosen the way of faithfulness; we have set our hearts on your laws.

Right: We hold fast to your statues, Lord; do not let us be put to shame. **Left**: We run in the path of your commands, for you have broadened our understanding.

Right: Teach us, Lord, the way of your decrees, that we may follow it to the end.

Left: Give us understanding, so that we may keep your law and obey it with all of our hearts.

Right: Direct us In the path of your commands, for there I find delight. **Left:** *Turn our hearts toward your statues and not toward selfish gain.*

Right: Turn our eyes away from worthless things; preserve our lives according to your word.

Left: Fulfill your promise to your servants, so that you may be feared.

Right: Take away the disgrace we dread, for your laws are good.

Left: How we long for your precepts! In your righteousness preserve our lives.

Right: May your unfailing love come to us, Lord, your salvation, according to your promise; there we can answer anyone who taunts us, for we trust in your word.

People: Never take your word of truth from our mouths, for we have put hope in your laws.

Right: We will always obey your law, for ever and ever.

Left: We will walk about in freedom, for we have sought out your precepts.

Right: We will speak of your statues before kings, and will not be put to shame, for we delight in your commands, because we love them.

Left: We reach out for your commands, which we love, that we may meditate on your decrees.

People: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.
