



<u>Theology</u>—Q27 – Is "original sin" in Scripture? Who formulated it and why?

- Our fallen hearts are inclined toward sin before any actual sin
- This root of sin, transmitted to us from Adam, is the source of all actual sin
- We are not sinners because we sin.
 We sin because we are sinners!
- We are born with a fallen nature that is enslaved to sin.

- <u>Total Depravity</u> = the implication of our original sin
 - The corruption of our fallen spiritual and moral nature is total in principle, although not in degree.
 - No part of us is untouched by sin; thus, no action is as good as it should be.
 - Yet no one is as bad as he or she might be.
 - Consequently, we cannot earn God's favor, no matter what we do (not able not to sin).
 - Unless grace saves us, we are lost.
 - □ Total INability

Westminster Confession of Faith 9.3—

- Romans 8.7—the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. ⁸ Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

Westminster Confession of Faith 9.3—

- Romans 3.10, 12—None is righteous, no, not one
- Ephesians 2.1—you were dead in the trespasses and sins
- Colossians 2.13—who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh

Westminster Confession of Faith 9.3—

- ... is not able, by his own strength, to convert himself, or to prepare himself to do so

Westminster Confession of Faith 9.3—

- 1 Cor 2.14—The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned
- <u>Titus 3.3</u>—we ourselves were once slaves to various passions and pleasures
