



## John Owen

Never let us reckon that our work in contending against sin, in crucifying, mortifying, and subduing of it, is at an end. The place of its habitation is unsearchable; and when we may think that we have thoroughly won the field, there is still some reserve remaining that we saw not, that we knew not of. ## Kingdom of God

- = a realm, not like on earth
- = wherever God's light and royal will is reigning
- = includes the Church, but it's more



#### Parable

(Greek: parabole)

- = comparison ~ metaphor ~ picture ~ illustration
- = concrete depiction of a cosmic truth
- = a story with symbolic, spiritual meaning
