### **Yodh**

**Left:** *Those who fear you shall see us and rejoice, because we have hoped In your word.*

**Right:** We know, O Lord, that your rules are righteous, and that in faithfulness you have afflicted us.

**Left:** *Let your steadfast love comfort us according to your promise to your servants.*

**Right:** Let your mercy come to us, that we may live; for your law is our delight.

**Left:** *Let the insolent be put to shame, because they have wronged us with falsehood; as for us, I will meditate on your precepts.*

**Right:** Let those who fear you turn to us, that they may know your testimonies.

**Left:** *May our hearts be blameless In your statutes, that we may not be put to shame!*

### **Kaph**

**Right:** My soul longs for your salvation; we hope In your word.

**Left:** *Our eyes long for your promise; we ask, "When will you comfort us?"*

**Right:** For we have become like a wineskin in the smoke, yet we have not forgotten your statutes.

**Left:** *How long must your servants endure? When will you judge those who persecute me?*

**Right:** The Insolent have dug pitfalls for us; they do not live according to your laws.

**Left:** *All your commandments sure; they persecute us with falsehood; help us!*

**Right:** They have almost made an end of me on earth, but we have not forsaken your precepts.

**Left:** *In your steadfast love give us life, that we may keep the testimonies of your mouth.*

### ***Lamedh***

**Right:** Forever, O Lord, your word is firmly fixed In the heavens.

**Left:** *Your faithfulness endures to all generations; we have established the earth, and It stands fast.*

**Right:** If your law had not been our delight, we would have perished In my affliction.

**Left:** *We will never forget your precepts, for by them you have given us life.*

**Right:** We are yours; save us, for we have sought your precepts. The wicked lie In wait to destroy us, but we consider your testimonies.

**Left:** *We have seen a limit to all perfection, but your commandment Is exceedingly broad.*

**People:** *Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.*
