BRIEF SUMMARY

Rev. Rod spoke of the following:

- It is not God's plan to cause anyone to be sick or poor
- It is always God's will for everyone to be healed
- It is our faith that determines whether we receive our divine healing
- It is through faith that we can appropriate God's healing power

But in all these, God is sovereign. He heals and chooses when and in what way. Scriptures referred to: John 10:10, Prov 4:20-22, Matt 18:19, John 8:32, Acts 10:38, Luke 5:15, Matt 4:23, Matt 8:2, Luke 7:7 and Mark 5:25-34

- Do you believe that God heals people today? Why or why not? How do we know God still does healing today?
- Share about any experience you may have had with sickness and healing:
 - i) Have you ever prayed for someone to be healed? What happened? Or
