- 5. Genuine compassion to share God's love will alter our life priorities. If we are going to invest our time and energy in God's work, we can't continue to do some of the other things we have been doing. We'll need to make new choices in light of new values.
- 6. "Christians today like to play it safe. We want to put ourselves in situations where we are safe 'even if there is no God.' But if we truly desire to please God, we cannot live that way. We have to do things that cost us during our life on earth but will be more than worth it in eternity."
