“Being Planted To Grow & Flourish”

- Read and declare Psalm 92:12-15 over your lives!
- 3 Main Points from last week’s message:
 - We are meant to grow and flourish!
 - One of God’s purposes for our life is for us to grow. Scripture says that as God’s people (the righteous) we shall flourish like the palm tree, we shall grow like the cedar of Lebanon. This is a promise for our lives. Spend some time discussing and meditating on what it means to flourish like the palm tree and grow like the cedar of Lebanon. Some pointers:
 - Palm tree – it is a tall and beautiful tree. Takes 6 – 8 years to bear fruit but it remains productive for 1 – 2 centuries. It has a long tap root that goes deep into the ground in search of sources of water and this allows it to remain fresh and flourishing despite the fact that it grows in the desert.
 - Cedar of Lebanon – known to be a strong tree and can grow up to 40 feet in girth. Largely used for architectural purposes e.g. masts of ships, beams and pillars of buildings.
 - We will grow and flourish if we are planted!
 - Growth doesn’t happen anywhere – it is not a random thing. The palm tree and the cedar of Lebanon had to be planted in the right place in order to grow to their full potential. Likewise there is a place for us to be planted – in God’s house! Share:
 - How you came to be planted in Skyline
 - How you can continue to be planted
 - As we plant ourselves, grow and flourish, we will be fruitful!
 - Share with each other areas in your life that have been fruitful in the course of being planted, growing and flourishing.
 - Share with each other about areas in your life that you are believing for God to cause you to be fruitful in.
- Pray for each other that God will continue to reveal the richness of this promise in His word into your heart, that you will continue to be planted and planted well, to grow and flourish and be fruitful in all God has called you to do!
