Read Psalms 43

1

In Ps 43:1-2 it talks about experiencing ongoing suffering at the hands of injustice that seems to have no solution. In addition, the Psalmist feels that God is far away and strangely silent.

In Ps 43:3-4 it talks about asking for guidance (light) from the Lord through His Word (truth). It also talks about a need for God's presence. Trusting God means learning to wait on Him and seek His face. Have you received revelation from Him in times of seeking Him? Share.
