**Key Idea** - Unanswered prayer is an invitation to intimacy - it's a relational interaction not a service transaction.

**Key Scripture** - Is 55:8-9, Mt 7:7-8, Mk 11:24

When we begin our Christian journey, we see prayer as black and white and rejoice in answered prayer. But as we mature, we enter the grey zone of unanswered prayer. Has this been true for you? What has your prayer life been like? How has it grown?

The bible clearly says that certain prayers will not be answered (Jam 4:3). But we know that God desires to answer prayers (John 14:12-14, 15:7, 16, 16:23-24) especially those in accordance to his will (1 John 5:14-15). What do you think it means to pray according to his will?
