Hebrews 11:6a Without faith it is impossible to please Him.

LESSON - Unless faith is present, prayer... giving... sacrifice....service does not please Him.

2

Hebrews 11:6b He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

LESSON - God is in the Rewarding Business. Reward is not based on works but based on faith. Boldness is an aspect of faith. We must learn to be eager, willing, and expectant of God's blessings.

QUESTIONS - Do you believe in a God of abundance? Are you comfortable with having abundance? What are you sowing now in faith?

Mark 11:12, 22,23 v12 Jesus was hungry - he had a need.

LESSON - Having needs does not determine your spiritual maturity. As long as you are alive, there will always be needs.

Mark 11:13 There were leaves, but no figs, which indicated that the tree had said: I will not give fruit. In a normal tone loud enough for the disciples to hear, Jesus responded, "Let no one eat fruit from you ever again". He then moved away.

LESSON - We must be bold to respond to situations, sometimes letting others hear the words we say. Then leave.

v20-24 Now in the morning, ... they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. Rabbi, look! The fig tree which you cursed has dried up.

LESSON - When your words don't give life, it may amount to a curse.

6

v23 Have faith in God. Have the type of faith, spoken, as in Mark 11:23

LESSON - it is possible to have faith in your heart, but not in your head. What happened to the withered fig tree is a lesson from Jesus for us to learn to SAY.

Read Rom 10:8,9

Whenever you hear God's word, there will be an infusion of faith. Believe in your heart, confess with your mouth. God is not going to do anything about the mountains in your life because He has asked you to do something about it.

Everyone of us must prosper (be blessed) to the fullest extent so that the gospel can be preached to all the earth. To do so, we must rise up, and we must speak to the mountains.

LESSON - Be busy confessing and believing.

Psalm 103:20 when we speak God's word, angels hear God's word and do God's word.

QUESTIONS -

Think about the words you have said today. Which featured the most: words of neutral communication and instructions, thanks and appreciation, scolding and criticism, prayer, worship and speaking to our mountains? What words would you like to feature the most?

Rom 10:8,9 talks about the Word of Faith. Confessing with our mouths and Believing in our hearts reinforce each other. Everyone share one Scripture that we are confessing and believing God for.

SUGGESTION - Make some of these your CG memory verses Then practice saying to the mountains what God's word say in your situation.
