## **Summary:**

- Waiting on the Lord in prayer involves engaging with God in an attitude that is expectant and responsive to His voice.
   (Ps 40:1, Ps 62:5, Is 26:8, Titus 2:13, Acts 1:14)
- God wants us to actively participate in what He desires to accomplish.
- When we wait and pray, we receive authority and ability to do God's work (Acts 2, Acts 4, Acts 10, Acts 16) and experience God's sovereignty (1 Cor 1:7-9)
- Waiting and praying is an ongoing, church wide activity (Acts 1:8)
