



## IV. Baptisms

### **A. Baptized into Christ**

*For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.  
Galatians 3:27*

*For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether  
Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to  
drink into one Spirit. 1 Corinthians 12:13*

### **B. Baptized in water into repentance**

#### 1. When already saved

*Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in  
the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit  
Matthew 28:19*

*He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not  
believe will be condemned. Mark 16:16*

### **C. Baptized with the Holy Spirit**

#### 1. Receive power for service

*I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is  
coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy  
to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.  
Matthew 3:11*

*But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon  
you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea  
and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. Acts 1:8*

2. Jesus baptizes with the Holy Spirit (Matthew 3:11)

3. It is a promise from Jesus (Acts 1:8)

4. You receive power as a result (Acts 1:8)



5. It is often followed by tongues

*When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Acts 2:1-4*

6. It happens in addition to salvation

*Now when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them, who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. Acts 8:14-17*

7. It is a sign that follows believers

*And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover. Mark 16:17-18*
