Genesis 17:4-10

- 1. I will make you the father of nations.
  - A. Ishmael: Arab countries and Nomadic tribes
  - B. Isaac: Israelites and Edomites.

Did God keep this part of the covenant?

Promise vs covenant. What is the difference?

- A. Covenant is a contract. Two persons or more enter into an agreement with legal ramifications.
- B. Promise is typically one way.
- 2. Your name is no longer Abram but you are now Abraham.
  - A. Abram means exalted father
  - B. Abraham means father of multitude

Why is the important? Who else did god change their name?

A. Sarai=my princess Sarah=noblewoman
B. Jacob=heal grabber. Israel=let God prevail

C. Hoshea=deliverer Joshua=Yahweh is salvation

D. Simon=has heard. Peter=Rock

E. Saul=asked for. Paul=small or humble

Who else did God change the name of in the Bible? Revelation 2:17

- 3. Make you fruitful. Yep Kings shall come from you.
  - A. All the ancient kings of Israel
  - B. All the Ishmaelite kings
  - C. All the Midianite kings.

Most importantly Jesus himself. So like double check

- 4. Who is establishing this covenant? How long will it last?
- 5. I will give you all of Canaan. Forever.
  - A. That is half of Iraq
  - B. That is half Syria

  - D. Piece of Egypt and Saudi Arabia

## The actual border would

- A. Cairo to Turkey (782 miles)
- B. Turkey to Kuwait (1400 miles)
