Introduction:

What does *gracious* mean? The root word it is derived from means: favor, be gracious to, generous toward, take pity on.

- Read Matthew 20:1-2

- Read Matthew 20:11-12

They are *Ticked* off at the Landowner's *Graciousness*!!

- Read Matthew 20:13-15

Both stories are about one thing: *GRACE*.

The more we understand grace, the more we're going to be drawn to God, the more we're going to love God, the more we're going to be grateful to God.

- Read Ephesians 2:8-9

***Truth*: It's not about *us*—It's always about *Jesus*.**

- **Every other religion is based on works, and you can summarize them in one word -- "*do*".**
- **On the other hand, if you were to summarize Christianity, in one word, it's the word "*done*".**

Jesus's heart *beats* with grace. Let's *Appreciate* God's Grace.
