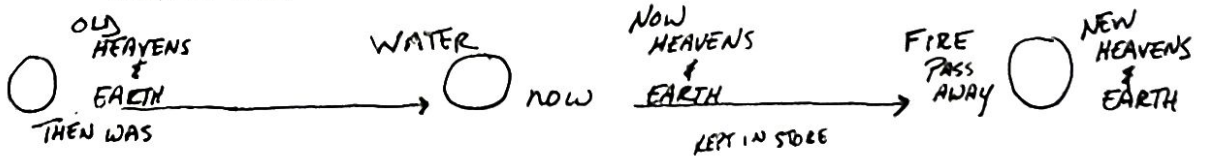
• See how things begin and their relationship to the end
