

# 1 CORINTHIANS | "THE WISDOM OF GOD Pt. 3" | LESSON 33 | (1 Cor 2:6-16)

## I) WISDOM / REVIEW

- Paul explaining the wisdom he speaks among the perfect
  - ① Not of the world & its princes > come to nought
  - ② of God, mystery, glory
  - ③ Princes didn't know about it (saving face)

## II) PREVIEW:

- ① Learning about God's wisdom. (1 Cor. 4:1)
  - (a) Progressive Revelation
  - (b) Darkened Revelation
  - (c) Hidden Revelation

## III) LESSON:

- ① Progressive Revelation - things God revealed a little at a time (hid in fullness, but not components)
  - witnessed → manifest
    - redemption in Christ
      - sacrifices, types, shadows
  - prophecy
    - the end & His coming to this earth
    - bit by bit → "the REVELATION" of Jesus Christ'

• Examples:

- ② Darkened Revelation - things God revealed, but were hid because of man's wisdom
  - (a) the law - 2 Cor. 3:14
  - (b) sin - Jn. 9:41, 15:22 (1 Jn. 1:8)
  - (c) God's wrath - Marc. 3; Rom. 2

• Examples:

③ Hidden Revelation: ~~not~~ <sup>we</sup> see I hid, and were hid because God hid it, not that man hid from it (as in Darkened Revelation)

Ⓐ This mystery - Rom. 9; 2 Cor. 5; 1 Tim. 1

Ⓑ hidden wisdom - 1 Cor. 2:7, 12; Eph 1

Ⓒ The mystery of Christ - Eph. 1, 2 & 3

- Progressive revelation can become darkened revelation
- Hidden revelation is the end of progressive revelation and can be darkened
- Progressive & Darkened Revelation common to man
- We need to know these kind of things to not mix things
- All revelation → eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, nor entered into the heart of man.
