III) LESSON:

① The Reign of Death

• Rom 5:12-14

• Paul provides a concise understanding of this time concerning the gospel of God, that is,

- [12] ① By one man sin entered into the world
- ② by sin death also entered (death is the sign of sin) ^{1 Cor. 15:56} "the sting of death is sin"
- ③ as, so death passed upon all men
for all have sinned

[13] - The Proof of the Passing Upon of Sin & Death

- ① Until the law sin was in the world (Adam passing)
- ② Sin not imputed when there is no law (conscience) (individual accounting)
↳ Phm 1:18
- ③ Death reigned from Adam to Moses
• over those that did not sin like Adam

• Gen 2:16-17

• From Adam to Moses God reveals

- ① His Word is true, and ② His kingdom operates upon Him, and ③ ^{God takes} serious sin and death & will have to be defended

• Gen. 5:1-5A - "and he died" ②

• Death becomes the consistent reminder of what Adam did and its passing to you

• No amount of human intervention and all extraordinary measures will save you from death. We will all succumb to death.

① Born dead spiritual

② Functionally dead → bring off own wisdom & flesh (that given by God) (apart from God)

③ Will physically die

weak

• Heb 9:27-28

• "appointed unto men once to die"

• From Adam to Moses we see the reign of death

• Even the patriarchs die

• Noah (Gen. 9:29 - 950 yrs - "and he died")

• Abraham (Gen. 25:7-8 - 175 yrs - "died in a good old age")

• Isaac (Gen. 35:28-29 - 180 yrs - "and died")

• JACOB (Gen. 47:28; Gen. 49:33 - 147 yrs - "yielded up the ghost")

② The Sin, The Curse, The Fall

• Gen. 2:9 (evil), 17 (eat & die)

• Moses is writing this after the events took place

• Written for the world, but for Israel to understand

• What has been given to Israel at the time of Moses

• Abs. cov. → Gen. 12:1-3, Gen. 13:15

• How can they dwell in a land forever when they die?

• Just as the law (the knowledge of sin Rom. 2-3), that which Moses writes after the time before the law provides the origin of sin & death

• Moreover, it details sin & death and their unbecoming makeup to the design, purpose, & nature of His kingdom on the earth.

• Gen. 3:1-6

• serpent uses the things in which present to subtlety lead the mind to sin against God, transgress the commandment.

THE CURSE

• Gen. 3:17-19

• "cursed is the ground for thy sake"
↳ destruction

• "in the day eat of it, surely die"

• The curse of the ground is a sign of "the curse" of death by sin

THE FALL

• Gen. 3:22-24 - The banishment from the kingdom

• Gen. 4:26-28, 2:15

• Sin lead to the curse of death that leads to the fall of man from that which God made him for

• Ps 8:4-5

• Mat. 4:8-11

• The kingdom is much more than simply possessing them but they, in truth, only function to their intended purpose by His R+T, life, etc

Conclusion:

• Therefore we see not only what God created and man's role in it all, but the further details are understood by their antithesis: sin, ^(death) curse, fall we are to know of R+, life, rise & blessing

• And the time from Adam & Moses reveals God's word of death being passed upon all men.
