Summary:

- The host of issues we have seen prove that the gospel accounts do not start something new, nor does the gospel in the gospel accounts share new information, but rather it shows exactly what Paul teaches.
 - ***Romans 15:8, "Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made unto the father:"***
 - Which is the issue of prophet, what God made known since the foundation of the world and therefore not a part of the revelation of the mystery, dispensation of grace, or the body of Christ.
 - The gospel accounts deal with the climactic stage in God's program of Israel and the fulfillment of prophecy, not the start of something new.
