 - Romans 5:20
 - Law entered that offence might abound
 - And it abounded
 - Romans 6:14
 - Sins dominion
 - Romans 7:5

- Motions of sins (which were by the law)
- Bring forth fruit unto death
- :10 found to be unto death
- :13 makes sin appear sinful, exceeding sinful
- Romans 8:3
 - Weak through the flesh
 - Cannot fulfill the righteousness of the law
 - :15 spirit of bondage again to fear
- 1 Corinthians 15:55-56
 - "the sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law"
- Galatians 3:24
 - "schoolmaster"
- Galatians 4:2
 - "tutors and governors"
 - :3 "in bondage under the elements of the world"
- Galatians 5:21
 - Hear the law
 - Bondwoman
 - Born after the flesh
- Galatians 6:1
 - Be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage
- 1 Timothy 1:7
 - It wasn't added for a righteous man
 - □ Added because of the transgressions
 - Lawful use of the law
