 - A wise man among you? To judge between brothers
- They were doing wrong
 - o To brother
 - O Didn't take wrong, didn't suffer
 - Defrauding offender in court

III. Sermon:

{:9-10} - "Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God."

- "Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God?"
 - 1. The unrighteous do not inherit what you will inherit, therefore, why do you go to them?
 - 2. The unrighteous do not inherit what you will inherit, therefore, why do you act like them?

"Be not deceived:"

- Led into error
 - 1. That the unrighteous inherit the kingdom
 - 2. That you should behave as them
- The list (works of darkness of Romans 13)
 - "fornicators"
 - Spiritual (idolaters)
 - Physical (adulterers, etc)

- "idolaters" 1 Cor. 8:4-6 (1 Cor. 5:10-11); 1 Cor. 10:7; Eph. 5:5
 - Connected to "lying" (Rev. 22:15)
- "adulterers" Jas. 4:4 "friendship of the world"
- "effeminate"
 - "soft" Matt. 11:8; Luk. 7:25
 - The world's exchange how God knit them in the womb (male and female) for the opposite role

• "abusers of themselves with mankind"

- Homosexuality (1 Tim. 1:10_
- Sodomy
- Secular
 - Documented Roman emperors
 - Philosophers
- "thieves"
 - break in and steal; robbers
- "covetous"
 - Very desirous; eager to obtain; inordinately
- "drunkards"
 - Excess, work of darkness, provision for the flesh
- "revilers"
 - To reproach; to treat with contemptuous language
- "extortioners"
 - To draw from by force or compulsion (going to law before the unjust defraud)
- Comprised list of "all things" referenced in :12 many of these things the law provided for

{:11} - "And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God."

- "And such were some of you:"
 - That is who you were (past tense), it is no longer who you are
 - You are (present tense)
 - 1. Washed cleansing of the internal uncleanness
 - Ephesians 5:26 cleanse and washing by the word
 - Titus 3:5 the washing of regeneration
 - "baptism" of the Spirit into Christ's death, burial, and resurrection

- 2. Sanctified to make holy, to set apart, to separate
- 3. <u>Justified</u> to be made righteous in the eyes of God
 - a. In the name of the Lord Jesus
 - b. By the Spirit of our God
- 1 Corinthians 1:30 God has made Christ to be unto us "wisdom", "righteousness (justified)", "sanctification", and "redemption".
- We are "purified" (Titus 2:11-16), we are a peculiar people and we are to walk accordingly.
 - Galatians 5:19-21
 - Ephesians 5:1-5
 - Colossians 2:1-9
