    - i. Abrahamic Covenant 430 years earlier (Gal. 3:17)
    - ii. Abe Cov. God's response to the vail of darkness spread over the nations from the scattering of the nation's due to the tower of Babel in Genesis 11
    - iii. God promised Israel to be a great nation, give them land, in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed
  - b. The Kind of Covenant
    - i. Romans 9:4 the covenants, and the giving of the law
    - ii. Ephesians 2:12 covenants of promise
    - iii. Galatians 3:10-20 the law ordained by angels (mediator Moses)

## 1. The Composition of the Law - More Education

- a. The Three Main Parts of the Law (Leviticus)
  - i. <u>The Moral Law</u> Exodus 20:1-17 governed in commandments and principles of righteousness and sin in relation to God and man. (2 Sections)
  - ii. <u>The Civil Law</u> Exodus 21:1-23:13 governed Israel in secular, social, political, and economic life
  - iii. <u>The Ceremonial Law</u> Exodus 25:1-31:18 governed Israel in worship, service, and fellowship with God. (priesthood, tabernacles, sacrifices, feast days, etc.)
  - Moral law reflected in the civil law and both temporarily atoned for by the ceremonial
    - Manifest in the NT during the Lord's Earthly Ministry
      - Sermon on the Mount
      - Sacrifices
      - Circumcision
      - Healings
      - Feast Days
