This Mystery

- **Romans 11:25**
 - *"For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in."*
 - Blindness in part (not all Israel) for their was an election of grace, but a blindness has happened to Israel
 - They have been blind before
 - The mystery is that God is doing something with Gentiles in regards to salvation apart from them, or during their blindness.
- Romans 15:8-12
 - Romans 11:11-12

Satan's Attack

- "boast against the branches"
- "not continue in His goodness"
 - Don't redeem the time, walking after the Spirit unto your calling, election, and vocation
- "ignorant"
 - "wise in your own conceits"
 - Not have a proper understanding of His goodness to us to fulfill our purpose of partaking of the root and fatness of the tree, but in turn attempt to partake of the

root and fatness of the tree to produce a fruit that isn't what we are to produce.

Introduction of True Godly Sanctification/Holiness

- "fathers"
 - He who begets
 - First, start, author
- "baptism"
 - A purification unto sanctification and new identification
 - We are supposed to have a great appreciation for our sanctification - Israel had a poor appreciation
 - A lack of appreciation results in succumbing to the lust of sin more and more, but also a lack of disgust for Satan's course of this world.
- 1 Corinthians 1:1
 - "sanctified in Christ Jesus"
 - "called to be saints"

 - All the problems at Corinth stem from a lack of appreciation and regard for their sanctification

 - :30-31 = *"but of Him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: that, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let Him glory in the Lord."*
- 1 Corinthians 5:6-8
 - That's more purging terminology, that's consistent with sanctification and even refers to Israel's calendar and feast and the aspects of God's Jehovahness that puts justification and sanctification into effect and he looks at Israel's calendar there and the issue of the feast of the passover and the unleaven bread because those rudiments of the world illustrated not only the justification and the sanctification issue but also illustrated the kind of attitude that Israel was to have towards the issue of leaven once they've been justified and sanctified, but the Corinthians didn't have that and that's why Paul's communicating like he's doing here but the issue once again is their inconsistency with their sanctification is in view.
- 1 Corinthians 6:9
 - one of the major reasons why Satan wants that doctrine suppressed and wants you ignorant of your sanctification so you don't look at it as God does is so you can't go on and fully appreciate your exaltation so you don't make that impact amongst the principalities, powers, mights, dominions, and thrones in the heavenly places that God has given you the capacity to make whom he has made you to be in Christ
- 1 Corinthians 8:1

- :9 = "take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock"
- 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8
 - When you think about justification your thinking about your relationship and your identification in Christ that produces compatibility and perfect harmony between God's righteousness and his justice, when your dealing with sanctification your dealing with the identification you have in Christ that produces perfect harmony and association and compatibility with God's holiness and that is something that is going to stand in stark contrast and contradistinction to the issue of Satan and his unholiness and his wisdom and his Adversarial-ship to God, and the course of this world and so forth.
- Romans 6:1-7:6
 - Ephesians 2:1
 - Ephesians 4:20ff
 - Romans 12
 - Titus 2:1ff
- 1 Corinthians 10:1ff
 - the two primary objectives of your godly sanctification; putting the divine nature on display to the honor and glory of God and repudiate your former participation and involvement in the satanic policy of evil in the course of this world also to God's honor and glory and to the dismay of the Adversary and his cohorts
 - there's more satisfaction, happiness and contentment in the provisions God made for what he was doing for them than what the Adversary had. Now that's what they in partaking of the spiritual meat and drink that's what they should have understood and they should have therefore when the temptations came along to look at what they came out of as better than what they've got now, they should have denied ungodliness and worldly lust and live soberly, righteously and godly in view of who they were, in view of their godly sanctification, they should have repudiated and had zeal for repudiating what they came out of but they didn't.
