# L17 | Prophecy 103 | The Timeline of the Gentiles | Dan. 9:1-27

## I. Intro/Review:

- The Abrahamic Covenant
  - Restrained, but not disannulled by the law covenant
    - 5 courses of punishment
  - The Palestinian covenant (when out of their land to bring them back bless them, do good)
  - The Davidic covenant not by the first, but by God
  - The New Covenant the spiritual good to fulfill the rest
  - 1. The 5th course of punishment has started
  - 2. Outside of land just as law stated
  - 3. Have the Palestinian covenant to look forward to
  - 4. Have the declaration of the New Covenant in future days
  - 5. Have understanding of 70 years under Babylonian captivity

## III. Sermon:

- Daniel 9 Context
- Daniel 9:24
  - 70 Weeks Determined = 490 years
  - 1. "to finish the transgression"
  - 2. "and to make an end of sins,"
  - 3. "and to make reconciliation for iniquity,"
  - 4. "and to bring in everlasting righteousness,"
  - 5. "and to seal up the vision and prophecy,"
  - 6. "and to anoint the most Holy."
- Daniel 9:25
  - "know therefore and understand"
    - Beginning "that from the going forth of the commandment" ("to restore and to build Jerusalem"
    - Point "unto the Messiah the Prince" (Matt. 21)
  - "shall be"
    - 1. **"seven weeks,"** = 49 years
    - 2. "and threescore and two weeks" (62 x 7 = 434years)

- Total = 49 + 434 = 483
- "the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times."
  - Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther
  - Matt. 24:1
    - Coming to seek fruit (Luk. 13:7; Matt. 21:1-22; Matt. 23:37-39
- Daniel 9:26
  - "and after threescore and two weeks" (thus after the seven weeks too)
    - "shall Messiah be cut off, but not for Himself:"
      - Ps. 110, Ps. 2
  - "and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary;"
    - "and the end thereof (city and sanctuary) shall be with a flood,"
      - Rev. 12:15-16
    - "and unto the end of the war desolations are determined."
- Daniel 9:27
  - "And he (prince) shall confirm the covenant with many for one week:" = 7 years
    - "and in the midst of the week (3.5 years) he (prince) shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease,"
    - "and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate," (abomination of desolation)
    - "even until the consummation"
    - "and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate."
  - 1. Three segments of time
    - 1. Two prior "unto the Messiah the Prince"
      - 1. 7 weeks = 49 years
      - 2. 62 weeks (why not just threescore and nine weeks?) = 434 years Total = 49 + 434 = 483
      - During this time
        - 1. 5th course of punishment (2nd & 3rd installments)
          - 2nd installment Media & Persia
          - 3rd installment Grecia and broken into 4 (Rome)
        - 2. Famine of the hearing of the word of God
          - Amos 8:11
          - John the Baptist Luke 3:2
          - Christ John 1- word became flesh
        - 3. Messiah's first coming
          - Isa. 7
          - Isa. 9
          - Mic. 5
    - 2. One after "Messiah be cut off"

- 1. 1 week = 7 years
- During this time
  - Crucifixion
  - Resurrection
  - Much change
  - Ps. 2, 110
- Destruction to build up (1st install to 2nd install) destruction to build up (4th install to kingdom)
- Luke 21:10-24(:25-28)
  - "times of the Gentiles be fulfilled"
  - "fulness of the Gentiles be come in." different (Rom. 11:25 in the face of Israel's fall (casting off of the branches) fulness of the Gentiles be come in."

# IV. Conclusion:

- Within the 490 years God
  - 1. "to finish the transgression"
  - 2. "and to make an end of sins,"
  - 3. "and to make reconciliation for iniquity,"
  - 4. "and to bring in everlasting righteousness,"
  - 5. "and to seal up the vision and prophecy,"
  - 6. "and to anoint the most Holy."
- By 483 years God "finished the transgression", "to make an end of sins", and "make reconciliation for iniquity".
- In view of this God reconciled the world according to His grace to extend grace and peace that man might be reconciled to God.
