2. Now Quickened - Eph. 2:1, 4; Romans 6 - Alive to sin - dead to God

1. Alive unto God

- 1) **<u>Justified</u>** Redeemed
 - 1. Forgiven all sins Eph. 1:7, Col. 2:13
 - 2. Imputed with Christ's righteousness Rom. 3:20-26, 2 Cor. 5
 - 3. Atonement Reconciliation Rom. 5:6-21

2) **Sanctified** - purified

- 1. Dead to sin Rom. 6:2
- 2. Alive unto God Rom. 6:11 (quickened)
- 3. Under grace sons Rom. 6:14, Rom. 8:14-15

3) **Glorified** - before Him in love

- 2. Raised and seated in Christ Eph. 2:4ff

And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power: In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ: Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

{Colossians 2:10-12}

- "circumcision made without hands"
 - Circumcision made with hands Galatians, Genesis 17
 - Figure of the true
 - Not what we can produce
 - Romans 4
 - In Christ
 - Not by our own works not what we can produce
 - "in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh"
 - Fruit of our circumcision of Christ
 - "by the circumcision of Christ" crucified with Christ
- Through the Faith of the Operation of God
 - 1. Circumcision made without hands circumcised with the circumcision of Christ cutting away separation
 - 2. Baptism identification
 - 1) Buried with Him
 - 2) Wherein risen with Him
 - The Faith of Christ & the working of God's mighty power
 - 1. Rom. 6
 - 2. Eph. 1
 - Thinking and Affection change
 - The gospel makes the guilty become guilty
 - The gospel sheds light on evil deeds
 - The gospel grants the knowledge of sin
 - The gospel humbles the heart and quickens the heart to change its natural disposition and thinking of self
 - Sinner need the forgiveness of sins
 - Light in darkened hearts received by faith
 - The necessity of Christ's death, burial, and resurrection for your own (justification)
 - Judicially
 - Positional evidence in the mind and heart (spirit bears witness with our spirit)

• Operation - working

• Definition - The act or process of operating; agency; the exertion of power, physical, mechanical or moral.

Verses

- And what [is] the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the **working** of his mighty power, {Ephesians 1:19 KJV}
- Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the **effectual working** of his power. {Ephesians 3:7 KJV}
- From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the **effectual working** in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love. {Ephesians 4:16 KJV}
- Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the **working** whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself. {Philippians 3:21}
- Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his **working**,[G1753] which worketh in me mightily. {Colossians 1:29 KJV}
