Read 1 Corinthians 10:1-13 **Prayer**

Summary Points:

- The 3rd Non-Ignorant Issue is in regards to "true godly sanctification/holiness.
- Paul utilizes the "things written" for examples to "not lust after evil things" and to admonish us.
- The context is Israel has been Redeemed and Sanctified, but they do not appreciate their sanctification and God's gracious provision toward them instead "lust after evil things", "were overthrown", and "God was not well pleased".
- Paul identifies the same lack of appreciation of the Corinthians sanctification. They too are "lusting after evil things": fornication, idolatry, covetous, drunkards, extortioner, adulterers, effiminate.
